

CATIONIC EXCITER & PAPAYAS

Mike Wallace, Island Botanicals, transplanted approximately 60 papaya trees in mid-June. He BioWashed a portion of them and left the remainder as a “control.”



By mid-September, the BioWashed trees were 10 feet high. The control trees (foreground) were still about waist high.



The BioWashed trees were loaded with papayas after only 90 days! Papayas normally require a year to yield fruit.



The difference in growth and yield is astounding.



The benefits are from increased cationic exchange in the roots. Better roots = better yields.



Bigger and better roots absorb more nutrients and produce hardier plants and earlier yields.
